

Online LL.M. Application Checklist

Join a growing and exciting field of law.

Those applying to the online LL.M. in Intellectual Property at Cardozo School of Law are required to submit the following materials:

- [Completed online application](#)
- A **\$50 application fee** (waivable by the university; connect with an Admissions Advisor for more information)
- **Resume**
 - The resume/CV should be current at the time of application and include information about education (including dates of attendance at universities and dates of degrees received) and work experience (including employer names and locations, position titles, dates of employment, and description of responsibilities for the position held)
- One personal **statement**
 - This double-spaced, typed statement should be two pages long and describe your reasons for pursuing an LL.M. degree. Include any information you believe would be helpful to the Admissions Committee in making its decision
- One professional or academic **recommendation**
 - One letter of recommendation is required and may be written by law school professors as well as employers or colleagues whose supervisory positions permit informed evaluations of your qualifications
- **Official undergraduate and graduate transcripts** from all colleges or universities attended
 - Transcripts are required from all colleges or universities attended. The transcript should be an official record from the academic institution, clearly indicating the dates of attendance, the courses taken, the grades received, and the degree conferred
 - A certified translation is required for all foreign transcripts not originally written in English. One must be made by a consulate, a professional agency, or the institution issuing the original document
- **TOEFL or IELTS score** (if applicable)
 - International students and domestic students for whom English is not a first language should [visit Cardozo online](#) for more information on English language proficiency, translation, and waiver requirements

All U.S. applicants to the online LL.M. in Intellectual Property must hold a Juris Doctorate (J.D.) from an accredited U.S. law school. Non-U.S. applicants must possess a first law degree, such as LLB or J.D., from an accredited foreign institution.

Application Process at Cardozo

For applicants to the online LL.M. program, please read below to understand how to apply.

1. Upload application materials via the [online application portal](#)

- Application form
- Resume/CV
- Personal statement
- TOEFL or IELTS score (if applicable)

2. Submit materials directly to Cardozo School of Law

- Your **professional or academic recommendation letter** should be addressed to “Cardozo School of Law.” Applicants must submit the original letter of recommendation on letterhead with an original signature to the LL.M. Admissions Office. The recommender may also email their letter if they so choose
- The **original, official transcript of your law degree** must be received by Cardozo in an unopened, sealed envelope with the issuing administrator’s signature along the envelope seal. Transcripts may be mailed directly to the LL.M. Admissions Office by the issuing institute or by the applicant
 - Student or PDF copies of transcripts may be accepted in extraordinary circumstances, and only if followed by an original transcript in the mail
