

## Online MSL in Data and Privacy Law Application Checklist

Those applying to the online Master of Studies in Law (MSL) in Data and Privacy Law at Cardozo are required to submit the following materials:

- [Completed application form](#)
- **Resume/CV:** The resume/CV should be current at the time of application and include information about education (including dates of attendance at universities and dates of degrees received) and work experience (including employer names and locations, position titles, dates of employment, and description of responsibilities for the position held)
- **One personal statement:** At two typed, double-spaced pages, the statement should describe your reasons for pursuing an MSL degree and include any information you believe would be helpful to the Admissions Committee in making its decision
- **One professional or academic recommendation:** One letter of recommendation is required and may be written by professors as well as employers or colleagues whose supervisory positions permit informed evaluations of your qualifications
- **Official undergraduate and/or graduate transcripts:** Transcripts are required from all colleges or universities attended. The transcript should be an official record from the academic institution, clearly indicating the dates of attendance, the courses taken, the grades received, and the degree conferred
- **TOEFL or IELTS score (if applicable):** International students and domestic students for whom English is not a first language should visit Cardozo online for more information on English language proficiency, translation, and waiver requirements

## Application Process at Cardozo

For applicants to the online MSL program, please read below to understand how to apply.

### 1. Upload application materials via the [online application portal](#)

- Application form
- Resume/CV
- Personal statement
- Unofficial transcripts
- Letter of recommendation
- TOEFL or IELTS score (if applicable)

### 2. Submit materials directly to Cardozo School of Law

- Your **professional or academic recommendation letter** should be addressed to “Cardozo School of Law.” Applicants must submit the original letter of recommendation on letterhead with an original signature to the MSL Admissions Office. The recommender may also upload the letter directly in your application portal or email their letter if they so choose
- **Original, official transcripts** must be received by Cardozo in an unopened, sealed envelope with the issuing administrator’s signature along the envelope seal or delivered via electronic parchment directly from degree issuing institute. Transcripts may be mailed directly to the MSL Admissions Office by the issuing institute or by the applicant
  - Student or PDF copies of transcripts will be accepted for review purposes, and must be followed by an original transcript in the mail or electronic parchment sent directly from issuing school
